Special COVID-19 Information for Moberly Resort and Marina

Based on materials from WorkSafeBC, the BC Lodging and Campground Association, and recommendations provided by BC's Provincial Health Officer.

We are going to have a fantastic summer- but health and safety needs to remain everyone's priority. We have implemented some measures that will allow us all to *be safe and feel safe*. As possible, we will open up even more.

Kindly have <u>each</u> person in your group read this info prior to arrival (share relevant parts with your children please).

- Even though we are outside in the great outdoors, remember to continue following the recommendations of BC's Provincial Health Officer: ensure physical distancing of 6 ft minimum, use appropriate hand- washing and cough etiquette, let's all continue enhanced cleaning, and stay within our own "zones" as much as possible.

- Strive to be self-contained and be mindful of personal space and social distancing. All children need to be supervised when in common areas please.

- Pack extra soap products and/or sanitizer for effective hand hygiene. We are providing two locations <u>exclusively for</u> <u>hand washing</u> so please; use them to keep hands clean!

- As necessary, use our water taps to fill containers for use at your site. Sorry, no playing at water taps kids!

- Limit site occupancy to allow for distancing and please, <u>no day visitors</u> - unless arranged in advance and they must sign in. Just let us know!

- Plan appropriately so that once you have arrived, you stay in place for duration of your stay as much as possible.

- At this point we ask that you do not pass back n forth to Provincial Park adjacent - thus limiting the number of interactions with unknown contacts.

- If possible, bring your own axe, dog shovel and/or other tools you may require to minimize sharing items.

- Use a tablecloth to cover wooden picnic tables (we have extra - simply ask!)

- Explain to your children that the playground must remain closed – unless you are only children there!!

- Use the shower house if you are residing in cabin or as needed for health reasons. Patrons are asked to use provided solutions to clean any contacted surfaces (except floors) after use. Flip flops are encouraged. Read and fill out the information/sign-in sheet posted at shower house. Leave door open to ventilate.

- Ensure that you wash/sanitize hands before and after using outhouses. Cabins have dedicated outhouses, while long-term stays may be sharing with others. Please keep it clean and tidy for your stay – just as you would at home! If it requires special cleaning attention let us know.

- Prior to your arrival, it is your responsibility to self- assess for any COVID symptoms and to confirm that no one has been in contact with anyone with symptoms. Also, post stay, please contact us should your health status change.

<u>Once you've read this, and, as the final part of your reservation, please forward the full names and telephone</u> <u>numbers</u> of ALL persons in your party for our contact list if we did not record during phone reservation.
